Request for proposals

The Town of Brookline is requesting bids for the paving of approximately 1.2 miles in length and 19' wide on Hill Rd. and .25 miles of Putney Mtn. Rd. with 1" of shim coat (3/8" type 4 mix) and 1-1/2" of overlay (1/2" type 3 mix). No mixes using RAP or RAS will be accepted. All driveways and mailboxes (where possible) shall have a 3' apron and intersecting Town roads shall have a 5' apron. All materials MUST conform to Vtrans standards.

Work must be completed before September 30, 2017. Please include approximate start date that would fit your schedule with your bid.

Bids will be on a per ton in place basis, the price must include all associated cost including traffic control, grinding end joints, sweeping and applying a tack coat. One lane of traffic must be maintained at all times. Please direct questions to Archie Clark Road Commissioner 802-365-7606 or Mark Bills Road Foreman 802-896-6091.

All sealed bids must be received by 6:30PM, April 19, 2017, at the Brookline select board meeting. Bids will be opened and read aloud. Late, faxed or e-mailed bids WILL NOT be accepted. All bids must include a current proof of workers compensation and liability insurance. The Town of Brookline reserves the right to accept the bid most favorable to the Town, and reject any or all bids.

The chosen contractor shall be responsible verifying all utilities (above and below ground) within the project limits, and take necessary precautions to protect utilities during construction.

The chosen contractor shall be solely responsible for repairing and/or paying to repair any damage to private or public property sustained during or as a result of construction activities to its original condition.

It is the chosen contractor's responsibility to comply with all OSHA and VOSHA requirements, maintain a safe job site, and protect the safety of the public.

All work performed by the chosen contractor shall comply with all federal, state and local regulations and requirements.
