

Traffic Ordinance Town of Brookline, Vermont

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 107 and 1008, and Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotate Sections 1971 and 2291 (1) (4) and (5), and such other general enactments as may be material hereto, it is hereby ordained by the Selectboard of the Town of Brookline that the following Traffic Ordinance is adopted for the Town of Brookline, Vermont.

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

The definitions of 23 V.S.A. Section 4 are incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE

The Ordinance establishes special traffic regulations on public highways within the Town of Brookline, Vermont.

ARTICLE III: SPEED REGULATIONS

On the basis of the June 7, 1989 Town of Brookline, Vermont Notice of Speed Limit Ordinance and the update changes of the School Zone, the following speed limits are hereby established.

All Town Highways – Speed limit 35 miles per hour unless otherwise posted.

State Aid Highway #1 – A maximum speed of 40 miles per hour on all paved sections of Grassy Brook Road, except the School Zone which has a maximum speed of 30 miles per hour.

Town Highway #10 - A maximum speed of 35 miles per hour on all gravel sections of Grassy Brook Road.

Town Highway #2 – A maximum speed of 40 miles per hour from the intersection of Grassy Brook Road north on Hill Road to Osgood's Farm, then a maximum speed of 30 miles per hour from Osgood's Farm north to intersection with Grassy Brook Road.


Town Highway #8 - A maximum speed of 30 miles per hour on paved sections of Putney Mountain Road.

Section 4. Designation: This ordinance may be referred to as the Brookline Traffic Ordinance and in a prosecution hereunder a copy of such ordinance, certified by the Town Clerk shall be prima facie evidence thereof. An allegation that the act constituting the offense charged is contrary to a specified provision of this ordinance shall be a sufficient reference hereto.


Section 5. Repeal of Prior Ordinances: Any other ordinance or traffic regulation heretofore adopted by the Town of Brookline is hereby repealed.

Section 6. Publication and Posting: This ordinance shall be published in the Brattleboro Reformer the week of November 8, 2010 and shall be filed with the Brookline Town Clerk on November 4th, 2010.

Notice of Adoption of Traffic Ordinance, Town of Brookline, VT

On November 3rd, 2010, the Brookline Selectboard members adopted changes to the Traffic Ordinance at the bi-monthly selectboard meeting. The only change (other than correcting typographical errors) concerned correctly numbering Harris Hill Road as Town Highway number 3 in the stop intersection section.

This Ordinance shall become effective January 2, 2011 unless a petition for a vote on the Ordinance, signed by 5% of the legal voters of Brookline is presented to the Board of Selectmen or the Town Clerk of Brookline on or before December 17, 2010.
