- 1) Putney Mountain Road - FEMA 4621 Repair. Project requires the removal of approximately 100 square feet of existing but damaged blacktop so that the final result is a smooth and continuous paved area that will be 80 feet long and 19 feet wide. Two layers of fresh black top totaling 4 inches is required; the first layer is approximately 2.5 in thick base followed by a top layer of approximately 1.5 inches. A detailed material and equipment description will be required as this is a FEMA project.
- 2) The Recycle Bin area on Grassy Brook road requires a 4 inch thick apron extension from the road edge approximately 25 feet by 100 feet long.
- 3) PotHole repairs on a 5 mile section of Grassy Brook Road, starting from the Green Iron Bridge to the base of Whitney Hill Road. Close to 30 separate pot holes of various sizes marked with orange paint with an estimated volume of 725 square feet +/- Repairs to the road surface must be ground 3 inches deep and filled with hot patch to make the surface level smooth and stable.
